Camera: DSLR (digital single lens reflex) camera with **100mm & 200mm Macro Lenses**.

Where to find butterflies: along un-mowed roads, gravel roads with puddles, old fields, prairies, edge habitats and in your yard on wild flowers.

When: Warm to hot (75F-95F) sunny days between 10 a.m. & 3 p.m.

Get Close: Find butterflies feeding or basking in the sun. Move slowly

Get parallel to the entire butterfly.
