

Labeling your DPI entries for CRPC Competition

You will need a competition number attributed to your name. To obtain this number, contact Carmina Pena, lomasi76@gmail.com

Your DPI label for each entry should look like this: **A08—TITLE OF DPI.jpg**

(Note: CRPC members with DPI Code Numbers under 10 need to add a “0” to their filename).

Explanation:

A, B, C and D are the four different DPI's you may enter.

Number is the number Bill assigns you as your competition designation —Tilde is the spacer between your label names

Here is an example of four entries for the DPI category:

A08—Green Frog.jpg

B08—Butterfly.jpg

C08—Skyscraper.jpg

D08—Fox at Dawn.jpg

We don't require the DPI's to be received until two days before the competition—
Sunday at 6:00 PM.

Both print and DPI entries have their scores called out and recorded on the appropriate score sheets.
